 Boys have achieved a pass percentage of 99.97%

- Maximum entry is from the Northern region comprising the states of : Chandigarh, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, New Delhi & NCR, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand
- In India, Southern and Western regions have the best pass percentage i.e. 99.99% followed by Northern region having a pass percentage of 99.98%
- In India, the Southern region has the highest percentage of girls i.e. 49.48%, who had appeared in the examination.

e.1 ICSE – Special Category Statistics

- **12980 Scheduled Caste** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 99.97%
- **7975 Scheduled Tribe** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 99.94%
- **49731 Other Backward Classes** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 99.99%

f.1 ICSE – Special Difficulty Cases

Candidates with Learning difficulty (Dyslexia etc) cases were **692** (78 candidates obtained above 90%).

Visually Challenged cases were **22** (7 candidates obtained above 90%).
